

# Carew.

ARMS.—Quarterly of twelve: 1, Or, three lions passant in pale sable [CAREW]; 2, Argent, three eels coiled vert [ELLIS OF TREVOAR]; 3, Gules, a dexter arm from the sinister side, embowed proper, clothed with a maunch ermine, and holding a fleur-de-lis or [MOHUN]; 4, Quarterly sable and argent [HOO]; 5, Azure, a fesse between six crosslets or [ST. OMER]; 6, Azure, three sinister hands appaumé argent [MALMAYNES]; 7, Ermine, on a chief sable three crosses patée argent [WICHINGHAM]; 8, Azure, a fret argent and a chief gules [ST. LEGER]; 9, Or, a lion gules [WELLES]; 10, Gules, a fesse dancettée between six crosslets or [ENGAYNE]; 11, Barry of six ermine and gules three crescents [? WATERTON]; 12, Vert, three piles wavy argent within a bordure azure bezantée [BRYAN].

CREST.—A lion issuant from a mast top garnished with six spears.
