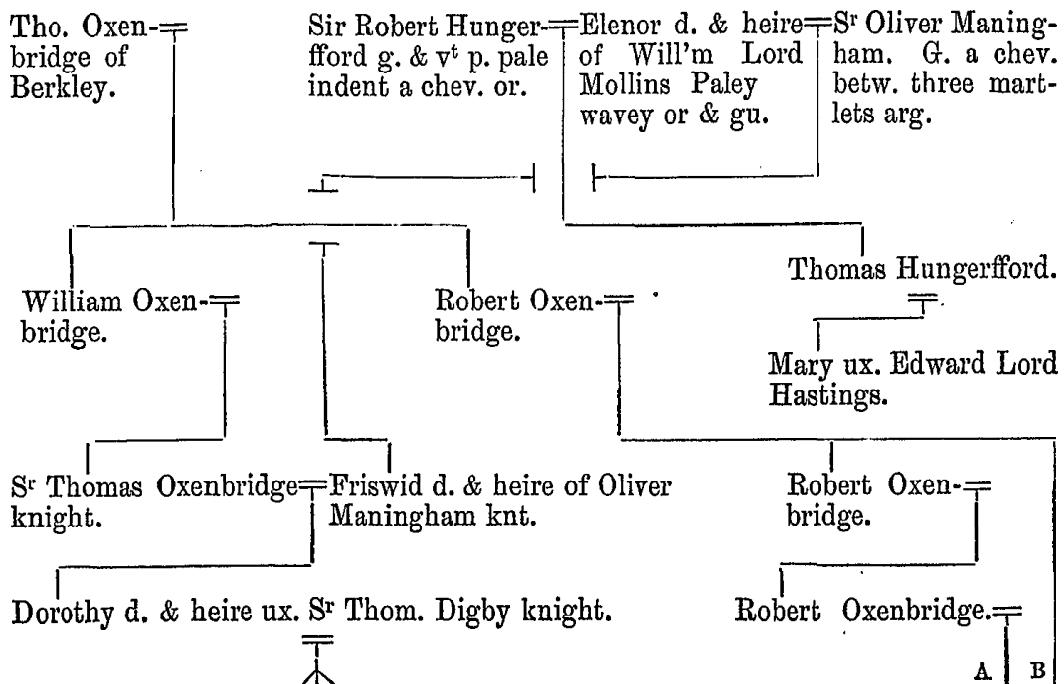
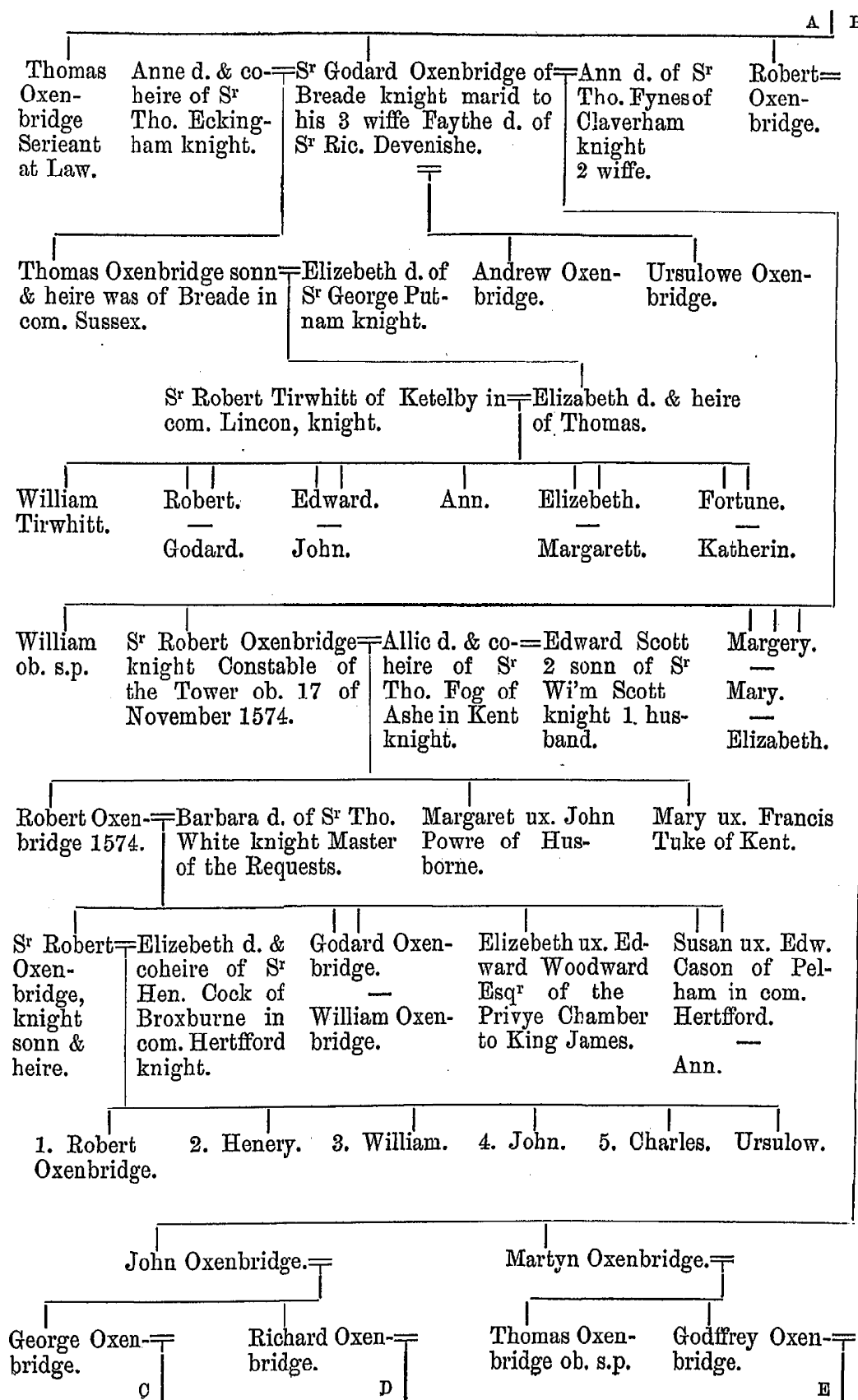
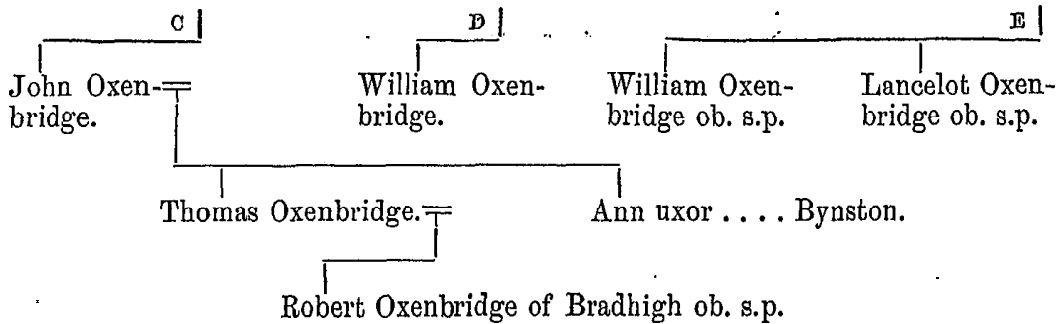


Oxenbridge.

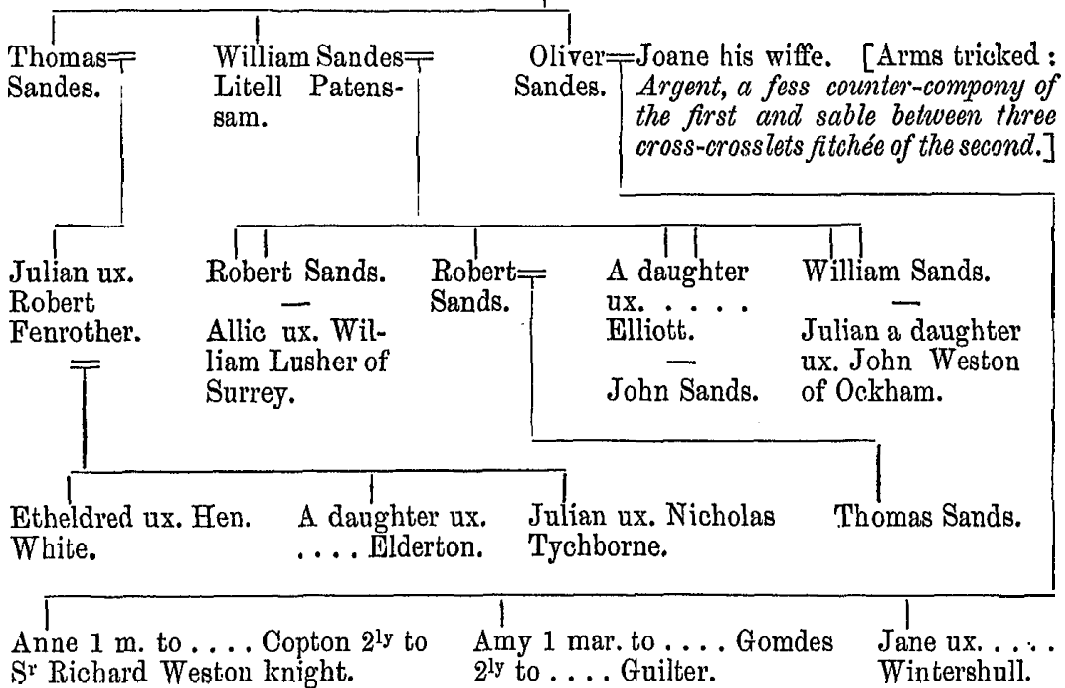




Sandes.

ARMS.—Quarterly: 1, Gules, a fess between six mullets argent [ASHBURNHAM]; 2, Or, two chevronels gules, and on a canton of the second a crescent of the first [ORREBY]; 3, Gules, a chevron between ten crosses patée argent, all within a bordure argent [BERKLEY]; 4, Argent, on a saltire gules five estoiles or; 5, Argent, three fleurs-de-lis azure; 6, [blank].

CREST.—Out of a coronet or, an ash tree proper, with bunches of ashen keys.
